Here is a small overview of the statistics for January and February this year.

Food received:

43% - bread

17% - eggs and milk products

40% - pasta, drinks, cereals, porridges etc.

We received food from:

Konsum (Coop) - 23% Tallinn's Food Bank - 20% Säästumarket - 17%

Finnish Food Bank Elämän Leipä (The bread of life) - 12%

Other small donators - 28%

We delivered food to:

People in need at Hapsal - 41% Society of big families (all county) - 23% Russian community in Hapsal - 10% Counties - 26%

Hapsal's Food Bank's situation is much the same as last year concerning the support we get. The second hand shop that we founded supported the Food Bank last year by 476 euros. There is no hope that we can receive more from the shop this year. The furniture store which we opened in October last year has not brought money in, so we are considering closing it down. I believe the reason for not selling is the bad economic situation that people are in – they do not buy furniture much.

If SB Foundation find it possible to support Hapsal's Food Bank this year, it would be a great support. With your help we could continue Food Bank activities and continue to receive food from outside of Hapsal, too.
