In India many important people are celebrated. During January, for instance, the School for Blind Children celebrated Brit Hodne, the founder of the school, who would have been 101 years old on January 10 – if still alive – as well as N.S.C. Boses who would have been 124 years old on January 23. Bose (1895-1945) was a politician from Bengal, i.e. present West Bengal, where the School for Blind Children is situated. He was a

member of parliament and fought for a free India. According to official sources he died over Taiwan on a flight to Tokyo. Some people, though, were of the opinion that he had survived and ended up in a Soviet prison, where he later died.
