Raj from the School for Blind Children in West Bengal, India, writes: "Here we have temperatures of about 40 degrees (Celsius). Such heat is not common this time of the year." He tells us that the authorities want schools to be closed for a week. But since most of the students of the School for Blind Children come from villages far away, they cannot be sent home on such short notice. Instead, the boarding school tries to arrange things as well as possible for the students. But before the extreme heat arrived, the school organized many activities.
