But such a 3-year education costs money, something that neither she nor her parents could manage. In spite of not being blind, she turned to the School for the Blind at the end of 2020, and the School, in turn, turned to SB Foundation.

Sweden heard about the girl's wishes and promised to cover her educational expenses. The picture above to the left shows Suchitra with her parents, when they visited the School for the Blind and picked up her first check. At the beginning of 2024, she concluded the theoretical part of the education and in the photos to the right we see her dressed in her graduation robe, happily holding her diploma and certificate of completion. Now only six months of internship remains before she can register as an RN (Registerd Nurse).



Here we quote a few lines from Suchitra's letter: Dear Friends, I am Suchitra Singha from Cooch Behar. With your financial support I could complete my 3 years of General Nursing & Midwifery course in Bangalore, India. Without your kind support this could not be possible for me and my family. I have already applied for internship here in Bangalore and after 6 months I will be able to register myself and work in

a Hospital as Nurse. I really thank you for your support, yours faithfully Suchitra Singha.
