This here is Bijoy. He is an orphan. He arrived to us at the School for the Blind in Cooch Behar when he was 7 years old, the current director of the school, Mr. Vijay Raj, tells us. He found the blind boy when he visited a tea plantation and suggested to his relatives that they allow him to come to the School for the Blind. Bijoy was a capable student with good behavior and followed the rules of the boarding school.

Bijoy finished Grade 12 with good marks and then went on to college. His dream was to work with computers. After college he tried several times to be admitted to such a course, but he never succeeded due to lack of space. But, on the 14 th of June 2024, he was accepted to a 1-year course at The Blind Relief Association of Delhi. "And on the 15 th of July we accompanied a very proud Bijoy to Delhi", Raj continues. "Bijoy's dream now appears to come true. All this has been possible because of intercessory prayers and economic support for Bijoy's education."
