"No one thought the war in Ukraine would last so long," writes Ülo Kalm from Hapsal in Estonia. He tells us that



most of the refugees who arrived earlier in the year have moved on to other towns but that in mid-November about 350 new refugees arrived and more are on their way. Daily, a group of them gather at Aiboland Museum to learn how to make camouflage nets. For the refugees it feels good to be



able to help their homeland in this way, even though they, themselves, are not in Ukraine. It also creates a warm fellowship between the inhabitants of Hapsal and the Ukrainians. With funds from SB-Foundation, the museum provides coffee/tea, cookies, and candy. Recently 40 nets were sent to Ukraine, and more are now ready to be dispatched. The local paper Lääne Elu has written an article about this undertaking.
