The SB Foundation has received a request from Estonia to support a project for 300 refugees from Ukraine. The project is that the Museum of Aiboland will arrange various activities, so that grownups as well as children can feel welcome in the country to which they arrived. The planned activities are e.g. openair concerts, bus rides to Noarroot-si, guided tours in the museum, coffee for free as well as fishing boat tours. During a certain part of the year herring is caught, and in Hapsal smoked Baltic herring is seen as a special treat. The refugees are also to witness that procedure and then be served the ready-made dish.

As can be seen in these pictures the museum has already started to manufacture camouflage nets. The ready nets are sent to Ukraine, where there is a great need for them. Refugees as well as Hapsala inhabitants volunteer to help with this work.



The SB Foundation also wants to pay for a school trip for all the 49 students in Martna School in Hapsal county. During the school trip the students will e.g. overnight in tents and do many fun and insstructive things – a life experience.
