In October 2022, we wrote about St Martin's congregation in Estonia and its need for a new electric organ. At the time we asked if our donors wanted to contribute to this instrument so the sound of beautiful music could be heard again by the congregants. We have told you previously about the camouflage nets that the inhabitants of Hapsala produce at the Aiboland Museum together with Ukrainian refugees. Fiftysix nets have been made and sent to Ukraine. As the photos show, the Museum has received two commendations for its initiative and work.
