The Andaman islands, India

Dear Friends and Supporters,









Andaman and Nikobar Islands, one of seven Union territories in India, are two archipelagos in the Bay of Bengal in the Indian Ocean. The Andamans are north of the tenth latitude, while the Nikobar Islands are south thereof. The population amounts to around 380 000 inhabitants. Christmas presents from the SB Foundation reached all the way to Port Blair, the islands' capital in common. The festivities started with worship in the church, housed in a colorful building, where children and young people participated in song and music. But also older people at elderly people's homes were visited and received Christmas presents. - The islands are in a very wet area and are often exposed to heavy rains, creating various problems such as flaking plaster and fading paint on the houses. Pastor Moses Massey is therefore appealing to the SB Foundation for help in buying water resistant paint for the poor congregation, which would cost about SEK 22 000, which we have not been able to promise.
