We often meet former students and, to our pleasure, see a positive development in their lives. Those who were in 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade when we began the school project have taken a step towards independent living and have succeeded in integrating into society thanks to their achievements in school. They have become adults and a few even have their own children. They greet us and ask how and what we are doing. We talk to them and ask how they are managing, where they work, if they keep in touch with each other, etc.

Cătălin works as a salesperson at “Zara,” Claudia has two children, her husband works in construction. Raul has moved to England. Rafael and Kalanios work as bartenders. Robert and Larisa have completed the secondary school program in sports and are gym teachers. Fulop works in construction, as do Leonardo, David, and Sebastian. Darius and Moses work abroad. Karol, Hoca, and Aurel graduated from the Industrial Design Group and are working in the service sector. Artur, Denis, Fabian, Ianos, Gabor, and Ruben graduated from Cluj Forest School Group and work in different areas. **I am proud of the students, says Dana. I feel great satisfaction that they have done so well and that we have been there to help them arrive to where they are now.
