MALAWI Sewing course

Dear Friends and Supporters!



Pastor Innocent Nangwale in Malawi shared that a group of women received a sewing

machine, but none of them know how to use it or how to cut fabric for sewing clothes. Innocent turned to SB Foundation and asked if the Foundation could fund a "sewing expert" to teach



the women for six months. When the Foundation agreed, Innocent explained that since the women have their own sewing machines and won't need to use the expert's machine, the fee would be lower. The total amount comes to 750,000 MWK (Malawian Kwacha), equivalent to SEK 4.200 (Swedish kronor). This price also includes the purchase of fabric and other materials. Innocent mentioned that the women are extremely poor and added that once these ten women acquire the knowledge, they can teach others. Some of them have already become skilled at sewing, he says.

We are so happy that SB Foundation can help ten poor people in the impoverished country of Malawi learn to sew clothes, and other items, mainly for their own families, but also to earn a small income by selling what they make in the market. We hope, these ten women will pave the way for more people who want to be trained.
