Yulia from Handelsbanken's Fadderbarnsfond (a not-for-profit Children's Fund that collects donations to improve the lot of needy children) was one of those who joined the trip, organized by SB Foundation in January 2025, to visit the Indian School for the Blind. One evening she took the lovely initiative of baking gingerbread cookies using a Swedish recipe together with a group of the younger blind and visually impaired students, who found it very exciting to take part in the baking. Yulia was wonderful with the children and taught them how to roll out the dough. The students could then use their hands to choose one of the gingerbread cutters and press out some cookies.



The baking trays were then placed in the new oven that Svetlana had acquired and uses for the school's daily bread baking.



It was especially fun for the children to eat gingerbread cookies they had baked themselves. "Can we do this again tomorrow?" they eagerly asked while giving Yulia a big hug.
