Elections have been held in Romania. Vicar Denes Csaba in Voivodeni Reformed Congregation was asked by the former local authorities to be responsible for the school lunch project, financed since a couple of years by the local authority (to 55%) and by the Foundation Bread (to 45%). Now he has encouraged the new local authority board to let the school lunch project con-

tinue. Happily enough he has succeeded and now the Foundation has paid SEK 56 500 for the autumn school term. We have also started paying contributions to various summer camps, such as

Our co-operating partners at Excelsior Foundation, who deal with the school project enabling Roma children to go to school, have sent us two reports which give a good insight in the difficult conditions that especially Romas live under and also show how much they benefit



from our project. We would be happy to send these reports either by e-mail or by ordinary mail to whoever who is interested. We do everything we can to finance the project with SEK 30 000 per month and are glad to see that many supporters have the specific wish that their contribution be used to help Romas in their home country. 86.8 % of the Romanian population belong to the Orthodox Church, which celebrated Easter at the end of May this year. On this occasion it was told at school about why we celebrate Easter. For several of the Roma children this was the first time they had ever heard about Jesus.
